

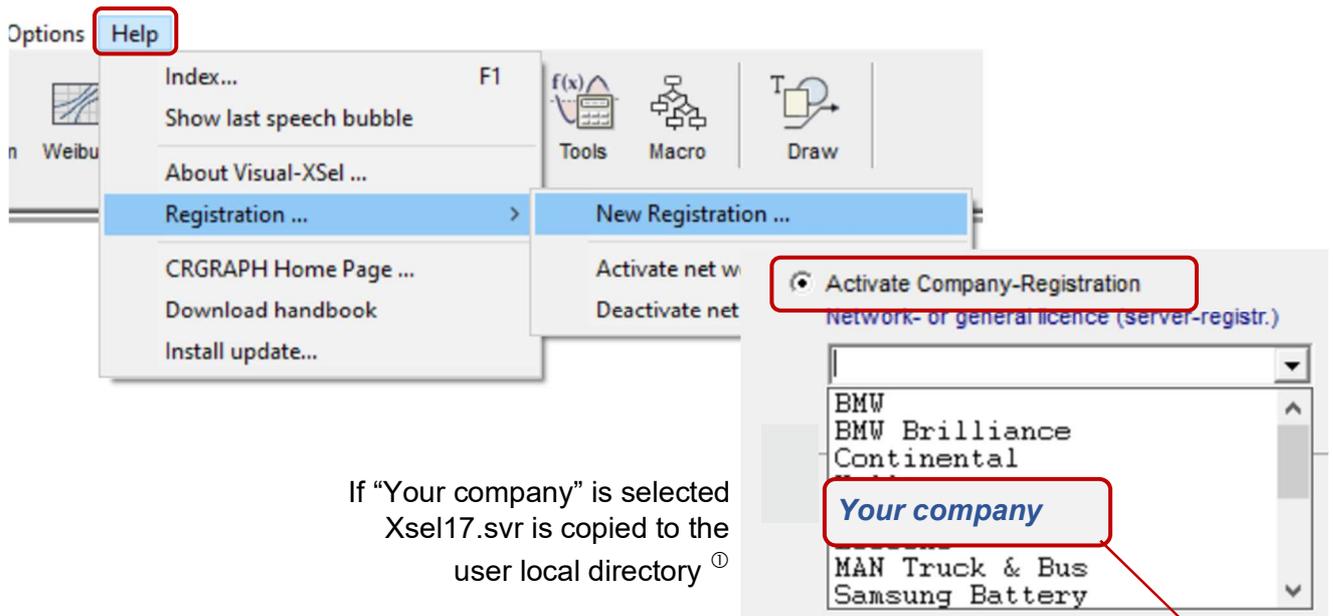


For a network installation, a directory is required on any server on which all users have read/write permissions. This directory can be freely defined.

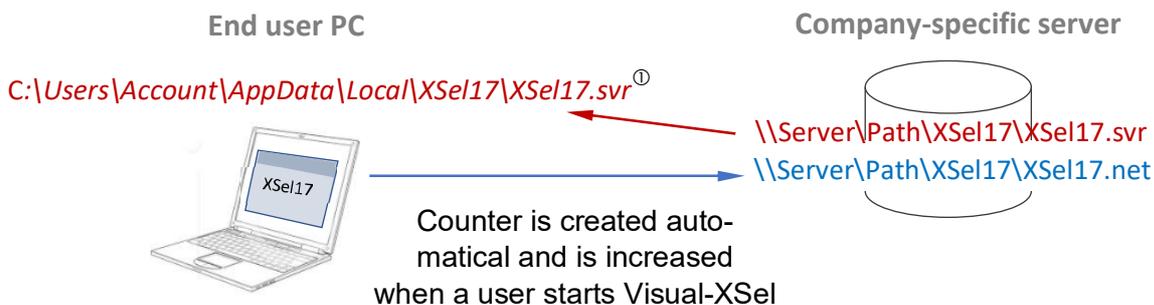
If it is not possible for different company locations worldwide different server paths are needed.

If a general read/write permissions of a directory is not possible, users must be given named access to this directory, e.g. via a digital administrative act.

The `\\Server\Path\XSel17\` in the pictures below is just an example. The full desired path must be given to CRGRAPH so that the XSel17.svr can be created. Please note: No drive letter can be used, the server path must begin with `\\`.



If "Your company" is selected Xsel17.svr is copied to the user local directory ^①



XSel17.svr contains the information of the shared server path. The file XSel17.net is then automatically created there by Visual-XSel. It contains the counter (binary file) of how many users are currently using the software and how much are allowed at the same time. It is reset after each day.

^① If "Your company" is not listed, but Xsel17.svr is available it can be copied manually in `C:\Users\Account\AppData\Local\XSel17\`
